What's New in 2009?

- É **MHSA Children's Pony Medal**
 Top 25 competitors invited to participate in the Finals and can be run concurrent with the Children's Pony division.
- É **Thoroughbred Hunter Division** (replaces Small Hunter)
 Limited to horses registered with or eligible to be registered with the Jockey Club. Top 25 competitors invited to participate in the Thoroughbred Hunter Classic. Prize money to be awarded in the Classic.
- É **MHSA Hunter Seat on Ponies**
 Eliminates the flat phase of the class and can be run concurrent with the division.
- É **Short Stirrup Equitation**
 Change the age to 10 Years of age and under
- É **The Equiery Maryland Resident Award**
 Awarded to the high point Maryland Resident from the following divisions: Adult Amateur Hunter - Older and Younger, Children's Hunter - Older and Younger, Small/Medium Children's Hunter Pony and Large Children's Hunter Pony

Deadline to Report Point Discrepancy

It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to rectify any point discrepancies thru **May 31st** by **July 31st** or the points prior to **May 31st** will stand as is.

It is also the responsibility of the exhibitor to rectify any point discrepancies by **November 10th** or the points after **May 31st** and prior to **November 10th** will stand as is.

All points are final as of **November 15th** of each year.

Please check your points carefully throughout the year and notify the office as soon as possible if you have questions.

MHSA Children's Pony Medal

To qualify for the final competition in this event the contestant must be in the top twenty-five in the point standings. Points to be scored 10-6-4-2-1-.5, regardless of the classification of the show. MHSA Children's Pony Medal classes held at shows beginning less than 15 days before the Finals competition shall count towards qualification for the next year's finals.

1. Class Specifications. The contestant must be a member of the MHSA and ride a pony and jump 8 or more fences of hunter type with or without wings. The course must contain an oxer, at least one change of direction, and two of the following which may not be combined: a bending line, a narrow jump (6ø8ø), a roll back turn, a fence at the end of the ring, or a long approach to a single fence. No in and out can be used. Small/Medium Ponies to jump 2ø and Large Ponies to jump 2ø6ö. Class to be judged on hands, seat, guidance and control throughout. To fill a class, 4 must complete the course. Only one rider per pony. The MHSA Children's Pony Medal class may be run concurrently with the MHSA Children's Pony Hunter division.
2. Each Member Show shall be entitled to hold a class for the MHSA Children's Pony Medal under the following conditions:
 - a. If there are 40 or more entries the class must be divided by every other number, by height of pony, or age of rider.
 - b. Application to hold the class must be filed with the MHSA prior to publication of the prize list.
 - c. MHSA Children's Pony Medal classes held at shows beginning less than 15 days before the finals competition shall count towards qualification for the next year's finals.
 - d. Entries for the annual Finals competition shall close five (5) days before the date of the Finals competition.
 - e. Exhibitors who lose their junior status as of December 1st shall not be eligible to compete in MHSA Children's Pony Medal classes held after the Finals competition during that year.
 - f. Exhibitors may not ride in both the MHSA Children's Pony Medal and MHSA Hunter Seat on Ponies at the same show.

The Equiery Maryland Resident Award

To be presented to the highest ranking Adult Amateur Hunter, Children's Hunter, or Children's Pony Hunter horse/rider combination that is a current Maryland resident.

The recipient would receive a keeper trophy and cooler, and have name engraved on challenge trophy.

The recipient would also be featured on the cover of The Equiery's annual Hunter/Jumper issue with a brief article appearing on the inside. The article would then be archived on equiery.com with links to mdhsa.org.

Thoroughbred Hunter

(replaces Small Hunter division)

Class Specifications. Limited to horses who are registered with or are eligible to be registered with the Jockey Club.

To be judged on performance and soundness. To be shown over a minimum of 8 fences 3ø in height.

Points will be awarded according to the rating of the horse show.

The top 25 horses will be invited to compete in the Thoroughbred Hunter Classic to be held at a designated horse show selected by the MHSA Board of Directors.

Prize money will be awarded in the Classic.

Short Stirrup Equitation Division *(new age limit for 2009)*

1. General.
 - a. Children eligible for short stirrup classes shall be **10 years of age and under** as of December 1st.

MHSA Hunter Seat Medal on Ponies

new class specifications for 2009 - eliminate the flat phase)

Class Specifications. The contestant must be a Junior member of the MHSA and ride a pony and jump 8 or more fences with or without wings. Two tests (USEF 1-9) are required during the first round. Only one rider per pony. Small ponies to jump 2ø6ö, Medium ponies to jump 2ø6ö, and Large ponies to jump 3ø. Class to be judged on hands, seat, guidance and control throughout. To fill a class, 4 must complete the course. The MHSA Hunter Seat on Ponies may run concurrently with the small, medium and large pony division. The Green Pony division cannot be run with the MHSA Hunter Seat on Ponies card as the fence heights are not consistent. However, Green ponies may jump in the MHSA Hunter Seat on Ponies class when the card is held open during the regular pony division if they so choose.
